Keep traffic flowing.</p>	<p>Support school staff in helping my child develop a sense of respect for others and their belongings.</p> <p>Assist my child in making sure they are neat and tidy.</p> <p>Support school staff to improve my child's academic and behavioral success.</p> <p>Follow visitor procedures by checking in at the main office before going anywhere in the school building or grounds during school hours.</p> <p>Cafeteria volunteers can check in at the cafeteria.</p> <p>Return phone calls and forms/notes in a timely manner.</p> <p>Make an appropriate time to meet with a teacher when I need a meeting.</p> <p>Let the school know in advance if my child will be absent from school.</p> <p>Be respectful on social media.</p>	<p>Make sure that my child arrives at school between 8:15 – 8:30am every school day.</p> <p>Help my child get up in the morning to arrive at school on time.</p> <p>Help my child go to bed at a reasonable time so they get enough sleep before coming to school.</p> <p>Encourage my child to eat breakfast before they come to school or attend the breakfast program.</p> <p>Make sure I contact the school, before 2:00pm, if I need a bus change.</p> <p>Try to make appointments for my child out of school hours so they have as few absences as possible.</p> <p>Attend Parent Teacher meetings and conferences.</p> <p>Provide my child with a quiet place in the home for daily reading and supervise the completion of their homework.</p> <p>Talk with my child each day about their school activities.</p> <p>Understand and support school expectations and policies.</p>	<p>Check my child's agenda to keep up to date with communication between home and school.</p> <p>Read with my child every day and check their homework.</p> <p>Find ways to help my child to practice behaviors that will make them responsible and independent.</p> <p>Encourage children to solve their own problems and be resilient.</p> <p>Read school memos and check the school website to learn information about our school and special events.</p> <p>Attend parent information activities throughout the school year.</p> <p>Contact my child's teacher to discuss any issues that may affect their learning and/or welfare.</p>
